

Notice inviting quotations for installation of GPS tracking devices in Water Supplying Vehicles


Sealed quotations are invited for installing and maintaining GPS tracking devices in Water Supplying Vehicles as per the details given below. A consolidated rate, showing the rent and rates, including all charges incidental thereto, shall be quoted per vehicle per month.

- A. Date and time during which the quotation can be submitted: 16.02.2017, 10 AM to 21.02.2017, 4 PM. (on all working days)
- B. Mode of delivering the quotation: Direct delivery or through post or courier to the Junior Superintendent, H Section, Collectorate, Wayanad (from 10 AM to 4 PM on working days)
- C. Form of quotation: Not specified
- D. EMD : Not required
- E. Details of work :
 1. Installation of GPS tracking device in Water Supplying Vehicles as required
 2. Maintenance of the GPS tracking devices during the period of operation
 3. Providing an online monitoring platform, which shall provide the following details
 - a. Current position of the vehicle
 - b. Course/path of running of the vehicle during a specified period of time. The period of time will be any time period, as fixed by the District Collector, during the currency of contract/operation.
 - c. Details of running kilometers covered by a vehicle on each day, period of halt during each day etc.
 - d. These details shall be available for the District Collector independently, without intervention of the bidder.
 - e. other GPS tracking and monitoring features

General Conditions

1. The device shall be made available on rent
2. The tender inviting authority will not be responsible for safety of the device.
3. The bidder shall install the device as and when work order is issued by the Tender Inviting Authority
4. All tracking and monitoring services, including online and offline and reports shall be made available to the Tender Inviting Authority and other users, who are specified by the Tender Inviting Authority in due course
5. No additional payment will be made for any reason whatsoever

6. Payment of money will be done only as direct debit to bank account. The bidder shall specify bank account details in the Bid Form
7. The bidder and employees/operator/engineer deployed by the bidder etc will be bound by the provisions of Disaster Management Act 2005.
8. Once the bid is accepted, the bidder is bound to provide the device in as many as vehicles, as required. In case, if the bidder fails to provide service, the bidder will be held responsible for the losses arising from and connected with it.
9. Quotation inviting authority deserves the right to accept/reject either wholly or partially, any or all of the quotation/s without specifying any reason thereof.
10. The bidder is bound to obey the directions of District Collector
11. Any repair costs or replacement costs or any other expenses during the period of work shall be met by the bidder.
